The MACCC fundraising wing of the MNGN kung fu club is now going to support one charity for the foreseeable future which will be the Nottingham University Hospital Children's Unit. Instead of holding one main event, we will have smaller fundraising events or competitions within the club, and each year there will be two challenges (one for adults and one for children) for students within the club to be sponsored. There may still be a children's fancy dress competition if we can liaise with a local school, more details to follow later. There may be a further source of income if Tai Chi displays are held at events for a small fee. The MACCC calendar sales made about £200 for the charity, and they contain key dates for 2010 to remind you of 3 hours kung fu details and when to check if your insurance is due for renewal.

Tai Chi students need to have insurance from December 2009 to cover the use and possession of weapons.

When taking your grading exams, please make sure that you have valid insurance or you will have your exam postponed until the insurance is renewed. Prices for the exams will stay the same unless the room hire fees change.

Prices for the T-shirts will stay the same unless the supplier changes the cost.

Weapons can be ordered from the website, the prices are already discounted for the club, but if you wish to order from other suppliers please check with Master Jago that the weapons are suitable and safe to use in class.

Kung fu prices will rise for the room hire at Noel Street Leisure Centre so the classes will be back at O2 Gym on Tuesday 12th January 2009

There is now a message board on the website for communicating with club members, just click on the relevant icon for either Tai Chi, Kung Fu or Kickboxing to leave your message.

Christmas timetables will be on the website so that you can check which classes are cancelled due to closure over the festive season.

Weapons class will return to the usual Thursday venue at the Healthy Living Centre, Bulwell in January.

Kung fu students who miss two or more 3 hour Sunday lessons in a 4 month period will continue to be given a red cross which will result in a 5 mark penalty on your next exam. To remove the red cross, you will need to attend all four of the 3 hour lessons in the next 4 month period.

Kung fu students must remember to wear their club T-shirts and grading belts to lessons. Failure to wear your belt from January 2010 will result in the whole class undertaking press-ups appropriate to the level of the missing belt.
